Case

How to do follow up, extend services, or resubmit a previously submitted Pre-Authorization request

Handling

Please follow the below steps:

1. in Case if the HCP wanted to a follow up, amend or resubmit an adjudicated pre auth request, then the HCP will create another pre-auth request.



- 2. In the 2nd Pre auth request, the HCP will relate to the previous pre auth request by adding Claim.related.claim field to highlight to the HIC that the new pre auth request is related to a previous one.
- 3. In 2nd pre auth request or any related pre auth request for the purpose of follow up, extension of services or resubmission, the HCP will include as well the Claim.related.relationship as "prior".
- 4. In the follow up request, the HCP will not change the service dates of the already provided or approved services.
- 5. The provider should always relate to the initial request. For example:
 - a. Request A was submitted
 - b. Request B was submitted as follow up related to request A (first follow-up request)
 - c. Request C was submitted follow up third time, providers should make the request related to request A.
- 6. The HCP will add any additional info under the Claim.supportingInfo to better highlight the case for the HIC approval.
- 7. The 2nd Pre-Authorization will be linked to the 1st Pre-Authorization.

Communication Handling on Follow up, extension of services, amending and resubmitting Pre-Authorization

Please follow the following steps:

• If the HIC wanted to send communication request to the HCP, they SHALL link that communication request to the latest recived pre auth request, through the following element:




• If the HCP wanted to send communication response, they SHALL link it with the latest pre auth request through the following element:

Cancelling specific Items:

- In case the HCP needed to cancel <u>one or a few items</u> and not all the items, then they need to follow one of the below two approaches based on the pre auth status:
 - 1- If the pre auth status is **Pending**, then the HCP will send a **Cancel** request and resubmit the pre auth again **with only the needed items**.
 - 2- If the pre auth status is **Adjudicated/Completed**, then the HCP will send another Pre auth request with **relationship = "Prior"** and linking it with the refernce number of the 1st Pre auth request (as highlighted in the **Handling** section) with removing the items that are not needed anymore.
