The purpose of this document is to highlight for the Healthcare providers, Health insurance companies and TPAs how to use the Payment cycle (reconciliation and Notice) via nphies.

SECTION 1.0 PAYMENT RECONCILIATION

Definition:

The Payment reconciliation transaction in nphies represents the payment notification that the payer sends to the provider in order to notify the latter of a payment(s) that been intitled based on a previously approved claim(s) amounts. This notification transaction will include (but not limited to) the following elements:

Date of initiating the real payment transfer	PaymentReconciliation.paymentDate



Section 1.1 Payment Reconciliation Transaction Purpose

- The Payment Reconciliation should first be initiated to report the paid advanced payment (if this
 practice is applicable to your business) which happens before adjudicating the recived monthly
 claims.
- 2. later on; after adjudicating the provider's monthly claims, another payment reconciliation transaction should be initiated and it should contain all the settled and paid claims for a specific period of time, for example if the payer is adjudicating the claims on a monthly basis, then the payer should initiate a payment reconciliation transaction containing all the settled claims during that month with a breakdown for each claim within the payment reconciliation PaymentReconciliation.detail.

Section 1.2 Claim & Payment Reconciliation Relationship

- Benefit + Tax amount: as expressed in the claim response.
- Early fee: amount that was paid in advanced based on the payer & provider agreement.
- Nphies fee: amount that was invoiced for the related claim.
- Claim Paid Amount: sum of the previous three fields.





Section 1.3 Payment Reconciliation Workflow & Scenarios




Figure 1- Payment Reconciliation Cycle


1st Payment Reconciliation: Advanced Payment via Payment Reconciliation

- 1. HCP submitted **100 claims** for the month via nphies.
- 2. HIC and HCP agreed on advance payment amount.
- 3. HIC will transfer the agreed advance payment to the HCP.
- 4. HIC will send a payment reconciliation for the advance payment including:
 - a. One PaymentReconciliation.detailobject
 - b. **Detail.type** = "advance"
 - c. without including any claim request/response identifiers.
- 5. HIC will adjudicate the claims.
- 6. HIC will send another payment reconciliation including:
 - a. PaymentReconciliation.detailobject for each claim
 - b. **Detail.type** = "payment" (if additional amount/payment is needed) or "adjustment" (if the advance payment covered all the payment)
 - d. Add the advance payment paid for each claim in component early fee extension (PaymentReconciliation.detail.extension.component-early-fee)




2nd Payment Reconciliation: Regular Payment Reconciliation

- 1. HIC has finalized the adjudication of the 100 recived claims, then sent out claim responses which has the following statuses:
 - a. 70 claims Approved.
 - b. 10 claims Partial.
 - c. 20 claims Rejected.
- 2. HIC will initiates real-world payment to the HCP for the amount(s) that was approved to be paid in the adjudication response (only the claims with Approved & Partial adjudication status which are **80 claims** in total).
- 3. HIC will send Payment reconciliation via nphies to notify the Provider that a payment been or will be sent with a breakdown of the amounts that been paid.
- 4. Within the payment Reconciliation transaction, each single claim will be represented by a **PaymentReconciliation.detail** element with a reference to claim request & response and a breakdown of the amounts as follows:







*Full structure of the PaymentReconciliation.detail data schema can be found in the nphies profiles.


- 1- In this scenario, the payer will report the **PaymentReconciliation.detail** elements for each claim with approved amounts.
 - o 80 Claims = 80 PaymentReconciliation.detail elements in the payment reconciliation.
- 2- Inside each **PaymentReconciliation.detail**, there will be a unique identifier represented by **PaymentReconciliation.detail.identifier** to discriminate each paid claim individually.
- 3- The sum of all the Paid Claims Amount (**PaymentReconciliation.detail.amount**) will equal to the total payment amount (**PaymentReconciliation.paymentAmount**).

Optional Scenario: Reverse Payment for re-adjudicated and paid claim

- 1- HIC have re-adjudicated one of the previously paid claims that was included in a previous payment reconciliation transaction.
- 2- Previous claim got re-adjudicated and revised to different approved amount.
- 3- HIC will update the payment reconciliation by sending the reversed amounts of that particular claim during the next payment reconciliation which will contain the other new claims that were adjudicated within the same period of the re-adjudication.
- 4- To indicate to the provider that the amount of a particular paid claim been reversed, HIC will add a **PaymentReconciliation.detail** element for that claim.
- 5- The **PaymentReconciliation.detail** will follow similar structure that was mentioned in **Scenario 1**, with the following considerations:
 - a. The PaymentReconciliation.detail.extension.component-payment, PaymentReconciliation.detail.extension.component-early-fee,



- **PaymentReconciliation.detail.extension.component-nphies-fee** should reflect the delta amounts.
- b. To link two different payments revised for the same claim; the HIC will report the PaymentReconciliation.detail.identifier sent in the previous payment and include it in the PaymentReconciliation.detail.predecessor for the new payment reconciliation for this particular claim.





SECTION 2.0 PAYMENT NOTICE

Definition:

The Payment notice transaction represents the acknowledgment <u>from the provider to nphies only</u> of reciving the payer's payment amounts for a previously adjudicated claim(s) amount. This notification transaction will include (but not limited to) the following elements:




Figure 2– Payment Notice Cycle
